in the Term of October eighteen hundred and fifty eight
of the District Court of the State of Ohio holden within
and for the County of Hamilton aforesaid, personally came
Henry Sauchman a native of Hannover

who came into the United States under the age of eighteen years, and
declared his intention to become A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, before
the said Court, agreeably to the ACT OF CONGRESS, in such cases made
and provided; and proved his residence and character by the oath of
W. Sture

and being admitted to CITIZENSHIP by this Court, took the oath to support
the Constitution of the United States of America, and that he
there did absolutely and entirely forever renounce & abjure all ALLEGIANCE
AND FIDELITY to every Foreign Prince, Potentate, State, or Sovereignty what
soever, and particularly to the King of Hannover

This is therefore to Certify, That the said Henry Sauchman
has complied with the Laws of the United States,
in such cases made and provided, and is therefore admitted A CITIZEN OF
THE UNITED STATES.
